# Vis-à-vis COP15

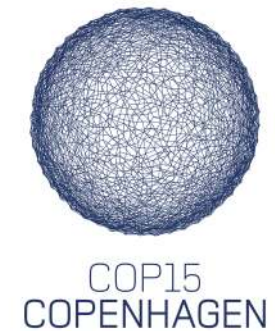


- Up-scaled financing a key issue.

# Strategic framework



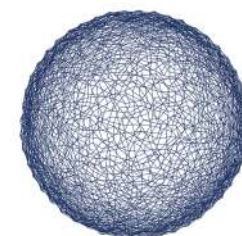
Now is the time. Important momentum and opportunities:
