

Trine Flockhart is Senior Researcher at the Danish Institute for International Studies (DIIS). Before joining DIIS she was Associate Professor at universities in Australia, Denmark and Britain. Her research interests are European Security especially the EU and NATO, norms transfer and state socialisation and processes of change through intentional agent-led action. Her recent articles have appeared in *International Relations*, *Journal of Common Market Studies*, *The Whitehead Journal of Diplomacy* and *European Journal of International Relations*. She is the editor of *Socializing Democratic Norms: The Role of International Organizations for the Construction of Europe* (Palgrave, 2005) and (with Norrie MacQueen) *European security after Iraq* (Brill, 2006). Her most recent publications can be found in *Journal of Common Market Studies*, entitled 'Europeanization or EU-ization; The Transfer of European Norms Across Time and Space' and in *Perspective on European Politics and Society* entitled 'Me Tarzan you Jane' – The EU and NATO and the (Re)-construction of Roles'. She is currently working a book entitled *The EU and NATO; Tales of Two Planets in One City*, a project on NATO's Defence, Deterrence and Posture Review as well as an anthology for Oxford University Press with Tim Dunne and Marjo Koivisto entitled *Liberalism and World Order*.
