

Restaurant recommendations

The restaurants in Copenhagen have a great reputation, so here are some recommended places to visit on your nights off during your visit.

Near DIIS, Østerbro

[Madklubben Østerbro](#)

A Copenhagen chain of restaurants with classical Nordic style and a cozy atmosphere inside a green house style building. 10 servings less than 400 DKK.

[Hos Fischer](#)

Italian style kitchen with several courses for less than 500 DKK in low-key and cozy setting.

Near Nørreport, central Copenhagen

[No. 30](#)

Natural wines, shared plates with focus on seasonal vegetables, small and intimate space with a hip vibe

Christianshavn

[Kanalhuset](#)

Old and beautifully restored building with ties to Denmark's colonial past, but now turned into a hotel/restaurant with focus on sharing with others when you sit at long tables and share the day's menu (150 DKK).

Restaurant [Lola](#)

Gastronomic fusion kitchen 4 courses for less than 450 DKK. The restaurant is inside an old and beautiful yellow town house in the middle of the old Christianshavn with a beautiful outdoor space as well.

Near central station/Vesterbro

[Paté Paté](#)

Inside the charming and popular meat-packing district (many nice restaurants and bars to find here) is the Paté Paté restaurant, the oldest in the district, with southern-European and north African fusion food.

Absalon

Inside this colorfully painted and old church many popular events take place including long-table shared dinner sessions for 50 DKK per person (buy tickets in advance).
