### Oprør og Alliancer. Mellemøsten efter Det Arabiske Forår

Bogen er nyskrevet! Fire steder har jeg anvendt eksempler, anekdoter og beskrivelser, der ligger tæt op ad formuleringer i tidligere udgivelser. Beskrivelsen af Perlepladsen i Bahrain side 72 er tæt på min beskrivelse i mit kapitel om Bahrain, skrevet til bogen om Det Arabiske Forår, jeg redigerede sammen med Clement Behrendt Kjersgaard og Helen Hajjaj i 2011. Det er baseret på mine egne oplevelser på pladsen. Side 155 henviser jeg til, at beskrivelsen af Mohammad Bin Salmans overgreb mod oppositionen har forlæg i et kapitel om Saudi-Arabien, jeg har skrevet sammen med Fannie Agerschou-Madsen, der findes i bogen *Mellemøsten Nu*. Beskrivelsen af de to hovedfronter i libanesisk politik side 332f ligger tæt på fremstillingen i mine tidligere publikationer om Libanon og der er i øvrigt tale om almen kendt viden. Anekdoten side 52 med professoren, lektoren og mig selv i Cairo i december 2010, hvor vi funderer over det netop overståede parlamentsvalg, mener jeg at have brugt i en tidligere publikation, men kan desværre ikke, trods ihærdig efterforskning, finde den eksakte tekst.

Litteraturlisten i den trykte bog er struktureret efter emne og geografi. I modsætning hertil er den Supplerende liste organiseret efter de enkelte af bogens kapitler.
