Thabit Jacob is currently a Postdoctoral Researcher at the University of Gothenburg. Prior to joining the University of Gothenburg, he was a Postdoctoral researcher at the Danish Institute for International Studies. His research focuses broadly on the political economy of development, politics, and geopolitics of extractive resources, politics of energy, and the role of state actors in shaping nationalist interventions in the extractive and energy sectors. He completed his PhD in international development studies at Roskilde University, where his doctoral thesis examined the political economy of resource nationalism in the Tanzanian extractive sector. Thabit is currently working mainly on political economy of energy including, but not limited to, renewable energy, state capacity in energy transition, energy access, and net-zero energy transitions. His analyses and commentaries have appeared in media outlets, including the *BBC*, *Aljazeera*, *CGTN*, *The Economist*, *The Guardian*, *Bloomberg*, *Deutsche Welle*, *Le Monde*, and *AFP*, among others. He has also offered advice to various International Organizations, Multilateral Agencies, Think Tanks, civil society organizations and political risk firms.
